D.U.I. (Alcohol) for Field Personnel:

CNOA and HIDTA are jointly hosting Driving Under the Influence (D.U.I. - Alcohol) for Field Personnel. This intensive, 8-hours workshop focuses on DUI Alcohol, a crime seen as being on the rise over the past several years. Taskforces, Checkpoints, and other countermeasures will fail without a base knowledge of the DUI (Alcohol) arrest and detection process. Through interactive lecture, hands-on exercises (No "wet labs" will be part of this class) and didactic modalities, this course will address:

- The legal framework and Courts testimony
- Improved Field Sobriety Test Batteries
- Report writing and crime elements
- Detection clues
- Apprehension tactics and strategies

This course will re-enforce the basics of a DUI (Alcohol) arrest and will cover curriculum from the National Highway Safety Traffic Administration (NHTSA) a National Standard.

Instructor: Inspector-Sergeant Matt Krinsky began his career with the San Francisco Police Department in January of 1982. His extensive career has included duties as a Patrol and Traffic Officer, a Field Supervisor, Training Sergeant, and as an Inspector (Detective) assigned to the Auto, Robbery, Night Investigations, and Hit & Run/Traffic crimes details. Matt has attended close to 1000 hours of advanced and in-service training relative to Traffic Enforcement and Investigation. He is nationally certified Instructor in the DUI instructor-Trainer programs from NHTSA, and manages the SFPD's Basic (40 hours) Traffic Collision Investigation and DUI update courses. Matt's knowledge and entertaining styles of delivery have garnered several awards for teaching, and he is an in-demand Subject Matter Expert for DUI (Alcohol) training.
