LOCATION: Orange County Sheriffs Academy, 15991 Armstrong Ave Tustin, CA 92782. From the I-5 Freeway exit Redhill Ave, proceed south. Turn left on Valencia and arrive at the old Tustin Marine Corps Air Station (Large aircraft hangars).
