DESCRIPTION: Indoor Marijuana Cultivations are increasing and it appears to be the wave of the future. Drug Cartels, Organized Crime and other criminal elements are turning towards indoor cultivations because of the lucrative profits they can achieve, the ability to produce a more potent product plus they have the ability to cultivate multiple crops per year instead of just one during the typical outdoor season.
